In the future, it will be important for all residents to overcome differences in nationality and cultures, understand and respect the diversity of the people, and coexist in harmony.


Therefore, starting from 2024, we have designated January of each year as "LIFE IN HARMONY PROMOTION MONTH".

Safe and Comfortable Society


A society where foreign nationals and Japanese build together. A society where all people can live safely and comfortably.


Diverse and Vibrant Society






