- **Disaster Prevention Exhibits:** Displays of the latest disaster preparedness goods and information-gathering methods during disasters, emphasizing the importance of daily preparation.
 - **Hands-on Programs:**
 - On **Saturday, October 4**, with the cooperation of the Tokyo Fire Department, we will offer **earthquake simulation vehicle experiences** and **initial fire extinguishing training**, providing opportunities to learn concrete actions during a disaster.
 - On **Sunday, October 5**, with the cooperation of the Tokyo Metropolitan Government Bureau of Urban Development, we plan to offer **VR-based disaster prevention awareness activities**, aiming to improve disaster awareness through more realistic experiences.
 - **Distribution of Koto City Emergency Food:** We will distribute useful emergency food items and promote the importance of securing food supplies during emergencies.
 - **Exhibition of Vehicles Active in Disasters:** Get an up-close look at vehicles from the Kanto Regional Development Bureau, Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism, Japan Self-Defense Forces, and the Tokyo Fire Department, deepening understanding of the activities of agencies involved in disaster response.
 - **Other Programs:** Various other organizations involved in disaster prevention will also host programs.
