Janna, founder of the sock company Bombas in New Orleans, Louisiana, donates one pair of socks to someone in need for every pair sold. Meanwhile, Ben, David, and Kevin, co-founders of the Ventura, California-based plastic recycling company Bureo, collect discarded fishing nets off the coast of Chile and transform them into functional new products such as skateboards, surfboard fins, and sunglasses. For millennials, social entrepreneurship is becoming a powerful and viable career path.
